Young children need to feel three things when they write and mark make: joy, purpose and magic. The Message Centre delivers all three of these in bucket loads. A simple rebrand of writing, messaging offers both children and adults a delight in what might otherwise be a struggle. When messaging takes off, the phrase 'reluctant writers' goes out the window! Children want to message – they love its simplicity and its warmth.
