This focused workshop will provide you, as a new governor or trustee, with the knowledge and skills you will need to be an effective member and contributor to the work of your board.

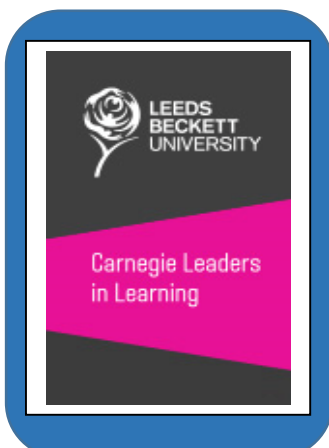
You will:
