

The Department for Education's (DfE) National Professional Qualification for Middle Leadership (NPQML)

Complete the DfE's NPQML with the Scarborough Teaching Alliance at Scalby School in partnership with SSAT, and ensure that you have the skills and confidence to progress in your career. Your role as a middle leader is fundamental to the success of your school and students and undertaking the NPQML with us will maximise the difference you can make.

The NPQML course involves working towards a change project in your school, impacting positively on your students and team. To give the skills, knowledge and characteristics to achieve this, you will complete 12 study modules, supported by a coach. You will also work through leadership competencies, intersessional tasks and professional learning journal.
