### Event Outline:

A session for schools 'Leaders of Reading' to generate effective, measurable targets to implement in school to improve early reading outcomes.

Led by English Hub Lead Hannah Spencer, attendees will be guided through DfE approved objectives to meet the three English Hub aims:

- improve phonics teaching
- language development and;
- love of reading.

Leaders will complete an action plan live, with the opportunity to ask an English Hub Specialist questions in breakout sessions.

Further support may be offered to schools to help implement these targets, e.g. funding for SSP accredited training or resources including decodable books, if schools meet our eligibility criteria.

- Lower than average percentage of pupils meeting the expected standard in the PSC;
- Low attainment in the bottom 20% of children;
- A higher than average proportion of children eligible for pupil premium;
- Ofsted judgement of Requires Improvement or Inadequate;
- A high proportion of groups considered hard to reach such as EAL, FSM, travellers etc; and,
- Schools referred by local partners (e.g. NLEs, LAs, Opportunity Area teams)
